Per Capita

GOLD \$75 and Up

SILVER \$60 to \$74

BRONZE \$50 to \$59

Largest % Increase

1 - 50 employees

51 - 250 employees

251+ employees

Champions Award

Recognition will be given to an agency if 20% or more of its givers make a contribution at the **CHAMPION LEVEL** of giving. (**Champion** givers are state employees who contribute one-half hour's pay per check.)

Money raised through special events will not be included in the calculation for the awards listed above.

Note: Awards are given on an agency-by-agency basis. Coordinators may recognize divisions of your agency for outstanding performance. See list on website.

Last year, 36 agencies received the Gold Award; 10 agencies received the Silver Award and 12 agencies received the Bronze Award. Sixty three agencies received the Champions Award.

If your Agency received a Bronze Award last year, why not try for a Silver Award this year; if your Agency received a Silver Award last year, try for the Gold Award. Look at your Giving History and see what your Per Capita was last year and what it will take to earn the Award for the next level.
